WALK-IN VISITS

Nurses & nurse practitioners are available to see students on a walk-in basis for the following:

- Acute illness & injury
- General medical problems
- Immunizations
- Lab work ordered by an outside provider

Health Services staff can provide treatment to Skidmore employees for:

- Minor injuries which occur at work & requires first aid only
- Blood pressure checks
- Hepatitis B vaccinations

If immediate medical treatment is required, seek treatment at Urgent Care/Wilton Medical Arts or Saratoga Hospital ER. For all other health concerns, employees should seek care from their primary care provider or community facility.

APPOINTMENTS

- Birth control counseling Chronic illness
- Physicals Gynecological exam/problems
- STD/HIV testing & counseling

SERVICES PROVIDED

We confidentially see students for a variety of reasons & provide care similar to what is obtained from a primary care provider.

CHARGES/INSURANCE

We DO NOT charge for visits to HS or bill health insurance. There are nominal fees associated with some medications & lab testing. Health insurance is utilized when a student is seen by an outside provider (Urgent Care, ER, specialist, lab, PT, etc.).

MEDICATIONS INCLUDING BIRTH CONTROL & PLAN B

We are not a pharmacy however, we do offer a variety of over-the-counter & prescription medications that may be dispensed during a visit.

Providers at Health Services have the ability to write prescriptions, including birth control.

Plan B is over-the-counter and may be purchased during a visit, at a local pharmacy or at Planned Parenthood.

No medications are handed out at the front desk or are dispensed to anyone other than the student being evaluated.

LAB TESTS

HS performs in-office testing for strep, mono, urinary tract infections, and pregnancy.

The office can draw blood/collect specimens ordered by a HS or outside provider and includes STD & HIV testing.

VERIFICATION OF MEDICAL ILLNESS POLICY

HS does not provide documentation of visits or excuses for missed classes.
