The final judging will be held on <u>April 4<sup>th</sup> from 11:30am-1:3pm</u>. Students must be able to present at the final event to be eligible to win.

#### **CRITERIA**

Judging: All proposals will be reviewed by representatives of the Office of Off-Campus Study & Exchanges. The top eight (8) entries will be invited to present to the judges during the Show & Tell event on April 4<sup>th</sup>, 2014. A group of judges will select a winner.

Entrants will be judged on the following criteria:

- Highlighting each topic mentioned above (Academics, Living Abroad, Coming home)
- Visual appeal/use of table
- Creativity
