Project

The Jeffrey and Cynthia Treuhaft Fund for Art Technology was established in 1999. This fund is designed to provide technology in support of student opportunities to work with faculty in new and innovative ways in any art form or medium. Project funds can support purchases of hardware and software for the College or provide other kinds of technological support for a wide range of projects.

Please provide a 500-750 word essay with your name, the date, and “Treuhaft Fund” as part of the header. Include in your essay the following:

- Title of project;
- A description of the means, methods, and technology to be employed in the project, so that its focus and feasibility are clearly set forth and understandable to a general audience;
- Themes you will explore in your work; include an electronic portfolio of work(s) that illustrate project goals, if applicable
- An explanation of where the art technology will be housed after completion of the project;
- A description of the nature and extent of collaboration with faculty and/or other students, if relevant;
- A description of how the project will enhance your Skidmore education;
- An explanation of the potential benefit of the project to the academic community at Skidmore and whether there is a public presentation of your work.

Budget

In a separate document – PDF or Excel spreadsheet – provide a detailed budget for anticipated expenses. Include a description of other sources of funds (if appropriate) or an assurance that funds are not available from other established sources at the College. Include your name, the date, and “Treuhaft Fund” as part of the header.
