

Spring and Summer, 2020

Thank you for your interest in Skidmore College's summer programs.

As an international student planning to participate in our summer program, you will be expected to have a student visa that will allow you to study in the United States. Applying for a visa can be a somewhat time-consuming process. We, therefore, recommend that you begin this process as you are applying to the program and possibly awaiting acceptance.

Please review the following memo and follow the step-by-step instructions for completing the **Application for Certification of Eligibility** form. This is a two-part form comprised of a <u>Biographical Data</u> form and a <u>Certificate of Finances</u> form. Please complete both forms and return them to our office at the address, e-mail address or fax number indicated below with the requested documents, immediately after submitting your program application. If accepted into the program, we will begin to process and issue you an I-20 Certificate of Eligibility for Non-Immigrant (F-1) Student Visa, if you meet the eligibility requirements for issuing you one.

If your attendance in the Skidmore Summer Program is being supported by another person (parent, spouse, partner, etc.) that person will have to provide 1) a support letter (sample attached) and 2) a letter from their bank (sample attached) showing sufficient funds available to support your program attendance. If an organization or a government agency is providing you with support, please provide a copy of the support letter. All documents not in English must include an English translation. Please see below for a translator's certification.

After we have received all the documents stated above our office will then mail you a packet that includes an I-20 Certificate. Please read and follow the instructions provided. Again, this is a timely issue so please do not delay.

Upon your arrival to campus, it will be your responsibility to provide our office with the following:

- 1) Copy of your passport ID page;
- 2) Copy of the international student visa;
- 2) Copy of your I-20 form with your signature; and
- 3) Copy of your I-94 arrival and departure.

RE: Application for Certificate of Eligibility (SEVIS I-20)

Congratulations on your pending acceptance to one of Skidmore College's Summer Special Programs, and welcome to the Skidmore College community. If you are not a US citizen, US resident or in a visa category that allows study in the US, you are required to apply for a student visa (i.e., F-1) in order to participate in any educational program in the United States. Colleges and universities are required by federal law to obtain several documents before we can issue a SEVIS I-20 (visa eligibility document). You will need the I-20 to apply for your F-1 student visa. **Note:** Canadian citizens do not need a visa, but they will still need to show their passports, SEVIS I-20 and other original documents at the Port of Entry to enter United States as an F-1 student. If you are already in the U.S. on a long-term visa, other than a B-1/B-2 visitor status, you may not need an I-20 or F-1 visa to attend a program in the U.S and maintain status. However, please provide us with copies of your passport and visa documents to us, so that we can verify if you need an I-20 and/or a student visa.

Please complete the attached, **Application for Certificate of Eligibility**, which includes a Biographical Data Form and a Certification of Finances Form.

Form Completion Instructions:

Biographical Data Form

- 1) Check to see that your name is spelled exactly as it appears on your passport.
- 2) If you have dual citizenship, note both countries and indicate which passport you plan to use when you enter the United States.
- 3) Please indicate your date of birth beginning with the MONTH, DAY, and then YEAR. (Please spell month, i.e., Jan, Feb, March, etc.)

Documentation:

Please provide the following documents -

- 1) A photocopy of the identification page from your passport
- 2) Photocopies of official bank letter, statements or other appropriate official documents certifying available funds to cover the costs of your educational expenses (If you have already paid the program fees in part or full, please include receipts for program payments). If the documents are not in English, then a translation of the documents must be included. The translation must be by someone who is fluent in both the language on the document and English.
- 3) If you are currently in the United States, a photocopy of your US visa stamp, and I-94.
- 4) If you are currently studying in the United States in F-1 status, also attach a copy of your current SEVIS I-20.

Financial Data Form Information:

Colleges are required by federal law to obtain documentation of available funds to cover your education or program expenses in the United States. In completing the Financial Data form you will need to estimate your costs for attending the program, and it would be best to err on the high side. Please refer to the website for specific program fees. The following is a list of charges to consider (not all charges apply to every program):

*Even if you are not staying on campus or on the full-meal plan you will still have to show equivalent funds to show you have enough funds to cover your cost of living.

Please provide accompanying documented evidence to cover expenses for the cost of study including: letter from bank on bank letterhead, scholarship letters, receipts from Skidmore summer program, if paid in full and in advance. Signature of bank official <u>must be original</u>.

Or

If sponsored by a person other than yourself (e.g., a parent, grandparent, spouse or partner, etc.) please provide the individual's name and a sponsorship letter from the individual stating your relationship to the individual, and the amount of support the person will be providing you (sample attached) AND a letter from their bank on bank letterhead stating funds available.

Or

If sponsored by an organization, please note the name of organization and provide a signed sponsorship letter from the organization stating the amount of sponsorship.

Or

If sponsored by a government agency please name the agency and provide the documentation for the specific amount of funding.

The total available funds should cover the approximate costs for your education in the United States. Please acquire the appropriate signatures and forward the forms and accompanying documentation to the Office of Special Programs.

Please attach the following documents:

- 1) A photocopy of the identification page from your passport.
- 2) Photocopies of official bank letters, statements, or other appropriate official documents certifying available funds to cover your expenses in the United States. (Note: you will need <u>original</u> documents for your U.S. consular interview to obtain your F-1 student visa). Canadian citizens will need to present the originals at the Port of Entry when they enter the United States.
- 3) If applicable, a photocopy of your financial aid award letter from Skidmore College or organization providing funding.
- 4) If applicable, letter of support from parent or person providing financial support.



- 5) If applicable, photocopy of sponsor's bank letter (parent or person providing financial support).
- 6) If you are in the U.S., a photocopy of your current U.S. visa stamp and I-94.
- 7) If you are in the U.S. as a F-1 international student, a photocopy of your current SEVIS I-20.
- 8) If you are in the U.S. as a J-1 exchange visitor, a photocopy of your current DS-2019.

Note: To avoid delays, please make sure that you provide us with <u>clear and legible</u> photocopies of documents.

The completed Application for Certification of Eligibility (Biographical Data Form and International Student Certificate of Finances Form) and appropriate documents may be faxed, mailed or e-mailed to your Program Coordinator.
