

Spring and Summer, 2017

Thank you for your interest in Skidmore College's summer programs.

As an international student planning to participate in our summer program, you will be expected to have a student visa that will allow you to study in the United States. Applying for a visa can be a somewhat time-consuming process. We, therefore, recommend that you begin this process as you are applying to the program and possibly awaiting acceptance.

Please review the following memo and follow the step-by-step instructions for completing the **Application for Certification of Eligibility** form. This is a two-part form comprised of a <u>Biographical Data</u> form and a <u>Certificate of Finances</u> form. Please complete both forms and return them to our office at the address or fax number indicated below immediately after submitting your program application. If accepted into the program, we will begin to process and issue you an I-20 Certificate of Eligibility for Non-Immigrant (F-1) Student Visa, if you meet the eligibility requirements for issuing you one. In addition, if your attendance in the Skidmore Summer Program is being supported by another person that person will have to provide a letter from their bank stating that the person has sufficient funds available to support your program attendance. In addition, if your attendance in the Skidmore Summer Program is being supported by another person, they will have to provide a support letter and a letter from their bank showing sufficient funds available to support your program attendance.

After we have received all the documents stated above our office will then mail you a packet that includes an I-20 Certificate. Please read and follow the instructions provided. Again, this is a timely issue so please do not delay.

### Upon your arrival to campus, it will be your responsibility to provide our office with the following:

- 1) copy of your passport ID page and the international student visa;
- 2) copy of your I-20 form with your signature; and
- 3) copy of your I-94 arrival and departure card.

RE: Application for Certificate of Eligibility (SEVIS I-20)

Congratulations on your pending acceptance to one of Skidmore College's Summer Special Programs, and welcome to the Skidmore College community. As a non-U.S citizen and international student you are required to apply for a student visa (i.e., F-1) in order to participate in any educational program in the United States. Colleges and universities are required by federal law to obtain several documents before we can issue a SEVIS I-20 (visa eligibility document). You will need the I-20 to apply for your student visa. **Note:** Canadian citizens do not need a visa, but they will still need SEVIS I-20 and other original documents at the Port of Entry to enter United States as an F-1 student. Secondly, if you are in the U.S. on a long-term visa, other than a B-1/B-2 visitor status, you may not need an I-20 or F-1 visa to attend a program in the U.S and maintain status. However, please provide us with copies of your passport and visa documents to us, so that we can verify if you need an I-20 and/or a student visa.

Please complete the attached, **Application for Certificate of Eligibility**, which includes a Biographical Data Form and a Certification of Finances Form.

### Form Completion Instructions:

Biographical Data Form

- 1) Check to see that your name is spelled exactly as it appears on your passport.
- 2) If you have dual citizenship, note both countries and indicate which passport you plan to use when you enter the United States.
- 3) Please indicate your date of birth beginning with the MONTH, DAY, and then YEAR. (Please spell month, i.e., Jan, Feb, March, etc.)

#### **Documentation:**

Please attach the following documents-

- 1) A photocopy of the identification page from your passport
- 2) Photocopies of official bank letter, statements or other appropriate official documents certifying available funds to cover the costs of your educational expenses (This can include receipts for program payments). If the documents are not in English, then a translation of the documents must be included. The translation must be by someone who is fluent in both the language on the document and English.
- 3) If you are currently in the United States, a photocopy of your US visa stamp, and I-94.
- 4) If you are currently studying in the United States in F-1 status, attach a copy of your current SEVIS I-20.

### **Financial Data Form Information:**

Colleges are required by federal law to obtain documentation of available funds to cover your education or program expenses in the United States. In completing the Financial Data form you will need to estimate your costs for attending the program, and it would be best to err on the high side. Please refer to the website for specific program fees. The following is a list of charges to consider (*not all charges apply to every program*):

Please provide accompanying documented evidence to cover expenses for the cost of study including: current bank statements or letter from bank, employment documentation, scholarship letters, receipts from program, if paid in full and in advance. Signature of bank official must be original.

Or

If sponsored by a person other than yourself or a parent, please provide the individual's name and provide a sponsorship letter from the individual stating your relationship to the individual, and the amount of support the person will be providing you (sample attached) AND copy of their current bank statement OR letter from bank stating funds available.

Or

If sponsored by an organization or person other than yourself or a parent, please note the name of organization or individual and provide sponsorship letter from the organization stating the amount of sponsorship.

Or

If sponsored by a government agency please name the agency and provide the documentation for the specific amount of funding.

The total available funds should cover the approximate costs for your education in the United States. Please acquire the appropriate signatures and forward the forms and accompanying documentation to the Office of the Dean of Special Programs.

All documents must be in English or must be translated in to English by someone who is familiar with both the language of the documents and English. The person translating it must certify that the person is fluent in both the language of the document and English and sign that it is a true and accurate translation. The translator <u>cannot</u> be the person applying for the I-20 or the person who is providing financial support. The person providing the translation can use the following format:

If you have any questions or concerns, please contact our office.

#### Please attach the following documents:

- 1) A photocopy of the identification page from your passport.
- 2) Photocopies of official bank letters, statements, or other appropriate official documents certifying available funds to cover your expenses in the United States. (Note: you will need <u>original</u> documents for your consular interview to obtain your student visa). Canadian citizens will need the originals at the Port of Entry when they enter the United States.



- 3) If applicable, a photocopy of your financial aid award letter from Skidmore College or organization providing funding.
- 4) If applicable, letter of support from parent or person providing financial support.
- 5) If applicable, photocopy of sponsor's bank letter (parent or person providing financial support).
- 6) If applicable, a photocopy of your current US visa stamp, SEVIS I-20 and I-94.

Note: To avoid delays, please make sure that you provide us with <u>clear and legible</u> photocopies of documents.
