CEPP had a lengthy discussion with Cori and Rachel about the decision to terminate Skidmore's relationship with IES London to provide the FYE London program. Cori Filson talked about the history of the relationship with IES London. Last fall OSCE had major concerns with their operations and the loss of staff and subsequent institutional memory. Cori discussed why she felt the program had changed and she had lost confidence in IES's ability to meet the social and academic needs of our students.

Cori and Rachel talked about their search for alternatives and the CEA CAPA program in London. They discussed their visit to the program, and had an extensive discussion with CEPP about the strengths of CEA CAPA in terms of academics and support, and the Proposal to Establish Affiliation with CEA CAPA London to Support Skidmore's London First Year Experience

CEPP voted unanimously to terminate Skidmore's relationship with IES.

CEPP voted unanimously to establish an affiliation with CEA CAPA for the LFYE.

CEPP re-affirmed that this change constituted a minor change that did not require a faculty vote.
