a. Executive Summary Review

- > Findings:
 - Inconsistency between department policies and practices.
 - Current policies are not effectively supporting departments and faculty.

b. Informational Questions

- o **CEPP Question:** Does the HHMI study group have a priority?
 - HHMI Answer: Addressing departmental inconsistencies.
- o **CEPP Question:** What is the ideal outcome?
 - **HHMI Answer:** Clarifying policies and their implementation.
- Discussion: Bob Turner mentioned the Stankowitz Report on bias in evaluations and will share it
 with the committee.

c. Recommendations and Process Discussion

- o HHMI Question: What changes would CEPP like to see?
 - **CEPP Comments:**
 - One-size-fits-all policies do not work for all faculty and departments.
 - Peer reviews are inconsistent across departments.
 - Lack of consistent training for faculty.
 - Inconsistent teaching and learning outcomes.
 - Need for structures to foster teaching excellence.
 - Faculty should show more self-reflection and vulnerability in teaching evaluations
 - Highlight and utilize Skidmore's resources to improve teaching.
