- 2. There was a brief discussion of the faculty only meeting and the importance of transparency going forward. Nick discussed CEPP agenda going forward for the rest of the semester, specifically]reviewing the summer teaching assessment, the QR assessment forward, and having Amy and Robert report out on Middle States.
