Steps to Follow:

1) Decide What You Want to Do: how will you make the world a better, more peaceful place?

Design your own project for peace that you will implement <u>anywhere in the world</u> during the summer of 2024.

2) Write a Proposal (please read instructions carefully):

To be considered, a student (or group of students) must submit:

- Application Narrative: submit a written statement which describes the project (<u>who</u>, <u>what</u>, <u>where</u>, <u>how</u>) including expected outcomes and prospects for future impact and sustainability (ideally 2 pages, not to exceed 3 pages, 10 pt. Ariel font)
 - a. All project proposals should be submitted with a heading that includes the following: name of all student participants, your school (Skidmore!), name of the participating/partner institution(s), title of project, proposed dates of the project, country where the project will take place.
- 2. Budget: (1 separate page) with budget liner notes/explanations
- **3. Agreement Letters:** must be submitted from all involved agencies or parties (project partners, organizations, foundations, local governments, etc.) in the project. This should be a letter, signed and on letterhead, from each project partner.
- 4. **Provide citations** (such as end-notes) for any statistics or quotations that are not yours.
- 5. Review PfP application guidance (separate PDF attached).
