

Five Year Out Alumni Follow Up Data for the Class of 2006

REPORT HIGHLIGHTS

- **Graduate School Attendance Rates:** 51% of respondents reported that they have either completed, or are in the process of completing a post-secondary degree.
- **Graduate School Achievements:** Of the 51% who have attended/are attending graduate school, 19% are pursuing Ph.D. or professional degree programs, and 7% have completed more than one post-secondary degree.
- **Gender Disparity between Graduate School Attendances:** 59% of female survey respondents reported that they are currently attending or have attended graduate school, versus 39% of male respondents.
- **Entrepreneurship:** 7% (22 respondents) report self-employment ranging in fields from health, art, hospitality, and business.

INTRODUCTION

This report is a profile of the Class of 2006, five years after graduating from Skidmore College, summarizing their career and graduate school pursuits. Due to the amount of time removed from Skidmore, the methods utilized when collecting data ranged. Email questionnaires were distributed from mid-May through mid-June 2011. Records updated within the past 18 months in Advance were used to supplement responses to the email questionnaires.

Data was ultimately collected from 65% of the Class of 2006, down from 76% response rate when compiling the year-out survey, the highest response rate ever received when analyzed in 2007. However, a 65% response rate is respectable considering the length participants have been removed from Skidmore. 61% of those tracked were women, and the remaining 39% were men.

Readers of this report are cautioned not to make predictions about future outcomes for Skidmore alumni based on this data. Although the percentage of the Class which was tracked was reasonably high, it would be risky to extrapolate from the 65% of the Class of 2006 from whom the data was collected. Since the mechanism for generating responses was a voluntary one, it is likely that there are some biases reflected in the data which was secured about the Class, and it is difficult to know the precise profile of the remaining 35% of the Class for whom no data was collected.

EMPLOYMENT

The top two areas of pursuit for the Class of 2006, five years out from Skidmore, were Business/Industry, followed by Education. The Arts was the third most popular category of employment, followed by Health/Science, Communications, Government/Law, and Human Services/Social Work. Notably, 22 Respondents, or 7% of the group, reported self-employment.

Of those who were tracked and reported employed, 41% of those were working in Business/Industry, while Education attracted 14% of the Class. 11% of those tracked were in the Arts, 11% in Health/Science, 8% in Communications, and 8% in both Government/Law and Human Services/Social Work (See Appendix A for a complete list).

The employment distribution for the Class of 2006 has shifted since the one-year out follow up report.

Business experienced the greatest increase, rising from 28% to 41%, followed by Arts, increasing from 5% to 11%. Government/Law increased from 3% to 8%, Health/Science from 5% to 7%, and Education from 12% to 14%. Communications decreased from 9% to 8%. Unemployed decreased from 4% to <1%. However, numbers may reflect bias as the 19% of those pursuing graduate degrees one year out from graduation have likely been absorbed into the workforce.

Within Business/Industry, the most common area of work was Banking/Finance, which comprised 30% of all business employment. Sales/Retail/Marketing was the next most popular category with 27% of those working in the business field indicating employment in that sector, followed by 13% in both Consulting and Other, 5% in both Computer and Sports/Hospitality, and 3% in both Manufacturing and Human Resources. The Business and Industry distribution also witnessed shifts since the one-year follow up report. Sales/Retail/Marketing experienced a 13% increase, rising from 14% to 27%, while Consulting and Other both increased from 7% to 13%. Human Resources increased from 2% to 3%. Sports/Hospitality witnessed the biggest decrease, dropping from 23% to 5%, followed by Banking/Finance decreasing from 33% to 30%, Computer from 6% to 5%, Insurance from 3% to 0%, and Real Estate from 2% to 0%. Manufacturing maintained at 3%.

Skidmore graduates were hired by a broad variety of employers ranging from prestigious organizations like Accenture, Cambridge University, Deloitte & Touche, Deutsch, Ernst & Young, Goldman Sachs, J. Crew, JP Morgan Chase, Kate Spade, L'Oreal, mTV Networks, New York Times, Nike, Paul, Weiss, Rifkind, Wharton, and Garrison, Pfizer, Polo Ralph Lauren, The Leith Agency, U.S. Department of State, and Valentino, to smaller, lesser known local employers. GRADUATE STUDY

51% of those responding to the survey are either currently pursuing graduate study or have completed graduate study. This number is a dramatic increase from the 19% pursuing graduate study reported in the year-out follow up data. 18% pursued or are pursuing Ph.D. or professional programs. 7% of the group either are completing or have completed two post-secondary degrees.

The Class of 2006 went on to study at many of the nation's leading institutions including American University, Cambridge University, Columbia University, Cornell University, Dartmouth College, Georgetown University, New York University, UCLA, Notre Dame, and University of Pennsylvania. See Appendix E for a complete list of graduate schools for the class of 2006.

The most popular programs were Education, Law, Business Administration, Social Work, Medicine, Counseling/Mental Health, Clinical Psychology, and Fine Arts. See Appendices F and G for a complete breakdown of graduate school pursuit by discipline.

GEOGRAPHIC DISTRIBUTION

Graduates of the Class of 2006 work or are completing/have completed graduate study in 30 different states and 13 foreign countries. 70% were residing in the Northeast/Mid Atlantic regions, mostly in the Boston to Washington DC corridor. New York was by far the most popular state with 25% of alumni living in that state. Massachusetts and New Jersey were tied for second most popular, each boasting 15%. District of Columbia is home to 7%, and California to 6%. United Kingdom was the most popular location for those living abroad with 3 alumni, followed by France and Switzerland, each with 2, and Antigua, Cambodia, China, Czech Republic, Germany, Israel, Japan, Puerto Rico, and Singapore with 1. GENDER DIFFERENCES

There were some significant differences between the responses of females and males to the survey. Men were more likely to be working in Business (43% vs. 26%), and Government/Law (7% vs. 5%). Women were more likely to be working in Education (14% vs. 6%), Health/Science (10% vs. 5%), Human Services/Social Work (7% vs. 4%), and Communications (7% vs. 6%). Arts were even, with both genders comprising 9% of the group.

While the percentages have modified in the years since, especially with Business, the trends of gender distribution are relatively consistent with the first survey.

Women were more likely to attend to grad school, with 59% either currently attending or have attended versus the 39% reported by men. However, men were more likely receive more than one post-secondary degree with 4% of males survey versus 3% of females surveyed.
