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FOLLOW UP DATA SUMMARY – CLASS OF 2013

REPORTING HIGHLIGHTS

Employment Trends:

- **Value:** 83% of respondents reported using interpersonal skills gained at Skidmore College often or occasionally in their current employment or graduate study pursuits. 82% reported using critical thinking, 75% reported using both knowledge and creativity, 72% reported interacting across social identities, and 64% reported quantitative reasoning.
- **Goals:** 65% of respondents agree that their current employment status relates to their long-term career development goals. 29% of respondents reported receiving and rejecting at least one job offer.
- **Top Employers:** Employers hiring the most Skidmore graduates from the Class of 2013 included: Skidmore Teach in China (9), Teach for America (4), City Year (4), AmeriCorps (3), NYU Langone Medical Center (3), and Success Academy Charter School (3).
- **Unemployment:** Unemployment increased from 2% in the Class of 2012 to 3% in the Class of 2013. According to the U.S. Department of Labor Bureau of Labor Statistics (March 2014), the national unemployment rate for those with a Bachelor degree was 3.7%.

Internships:

- **Top Internship Sites:** Sites that provided the most liberal learning practices included: Skidmore Collaborative Research (45), Skidmore College (7), Saratoga Opera (5), Saratoga Arts (5), Saratoga Hospital (4), and Tang Teaching Museum (4).

Graduate School:

- **Graduate Schools:** 12% of the Class of 2013 pursued graduate school within one year. The most popular graduate schools attended were Columbia University and New York University, each with 6 attendees.
- **Advanced Study:** 27% of those attending graduate school immediately were pursuing J.D., M.D., or Doctoral Programs, in fields such as: Medicine, Law, Physical Therapy, and Clinical Psychology.

Geographic Distribution:

- **Global Impact:** 17% of respondents reported working or pursuing graduate school abroad, in locations including: China, France, Spain, Italy, Germany, Canada, and the United Kingdom.

INTRODUCTION

This report is a profile of the Class of 2013 summarizing their career and graduate school pursuits. This data was collected from a variety of campus sources as well as questionnaires emailed and telephone calls made from May 2013 to April 2014. Data was collected from 75% of the Class. 64% of those tracked were women, 34% were men, and 2% did not identify.

EMPLOYMENT SUMMARY

81% of respondents reported employment. The two top areas of pursuit for the Class of 2013 were employment in Business followed by jobs in the field of Education. Health/Science and Arts were the third most popular categories of employment followed by Communications, Government/Law, Civic Engagement/Human Services, Self-Employment, and Social Work.

30% of those tracked were working in Business, while Education attracted 15% of the group. 10% of those tracked had jobs in Health/Science and Arts, 7% in Communications, 3% in Government / Law and Civic Engagement/Human Services, 2% in Self-Employment, and 1% in Social Work.

Unemployment increased from 2% in the Class of 2012 to 3% in the Class of 2013. According to the U.S. Bureau of Labor Statistics (March 2014), the unemployment rate for those with a Bachelor degree was 3.7%. 4% of respondents were voluntarily out of the work force, the same percentage reported in the Class of 2012.

Within the Business & Industry Distribution, the most common areas of work were Sales/Retail/Marketing at 28%, followed Banking/Finance at 23%, Sports/Hospitality at 17%, Other at 11%, Manufacturing and Consulting each at 8%, Computer at 5%, and Insurance at 0%.

GRADUATE STUDY SUMMARY

12% of those tracked were pursuing graduate study, decreasing from the 16% figure that was registered for the Class of 2012, and consistent with the long-term average for graduate study. An average of 17% of those tracked for the classes of 1999-2009 indicated that they were pursuing graduate study within a year after graduation.

The Class of 2013 went on to study at many leading institutions including Columbia University, Cornell University, Dartmouth College, New York University, Northwestern University, University of Chicago, University of Pennsylvania, and Washington University St. Louis. See Appendix D for a complete list of graduate schools for the Class of 2013.

Of those attending graduate school immediately following graduation, 13% were pursuing Social Work, 12% Education, 8% Physical Therapy, and 5% Veterinary Medicine. 4% reported pursuing study in Accounting, Dentistry, and Law. 27% of respondents were pursuing J.D., M.D., or Doctoral programs immediately following graduation.

GEOGRAPHIC DISTRIBUTION SUMMARY

Graduates of the Class of 2013 started work or graduate study in 33 different states and 17 foreign countries. 71% of respondents were residing in the Northeast/Mid-Atlantic region, in the Boston to Washington corridor.

New York was by far the most popular state with 44% of graduates working or studying in that state. Massachusetts was the next most popular destination with 17% of graduates working or studying there.

4% of those tracked worked or studied in California or Connecticut, 3% in New Jersey, and 2% in Pennsylvania, Ohio, or Vermont. 1% were located in Illinois, Maryland, Minnesota, New Hampshire, Oregon, Rhode Island, South Carolina, and Washington.

China was the most common location for those working abroad with 10 respondents residing there, followed by 2 in Canada, France, Germany, Italy, Spain, and the United Kingdom See Appendix F for a complete geographic distribution for the Class of 2013.

GENDER DIFFERENCES

There were some significant differences between the responses of females and males to the survey. Men were more likely to be working in Business (35% vs. 27%), Health/Science (11% vs. 9%), and Communications (14% vs. 4%). Women were more likely to be working in the Arts (10% vs. 9%) and Education (18% vs. 10%). Figures for males and females were similar in other areas of employment. Unemployment was higher for males at 5% vs. 1% for females.

Women were more likely to attend graduate school immediately following graduation (13% vs. 9%)
