1) Associate Dean of the Faculty Michael Arnush joins CEPP to discuss CAS proposal.

Michael Arnush spoke on behalf of Committee for Academic Standing (CAS), presenting a proposal to shorten the deadline for students to complete incomplete work by one week (for Fall semester only). This would enable students on academic probation to learn about their standing/discuss academic plans with CAS and other relevant parties sooner. The committee voted in support of the proposal.

2) Continue discussing CEPP's Spring 2021 plan for reforming the teaching evaluation process towards a more holistic model.

The Committee continued its discussion of reforming the teaching evaluation process at Skidmore. The Committee discussed ways to define and demonstrate effective teaching, and what other Committees/constituents to include in such discussions (e.g., ATC, PC, CAFR). The committee will continue to consider the following categories in further discussion.

Main Categories

- 1. Peer evaluation
 - a. Define its constituent parts
 - b. Each department articulates its own policies
 - c. Educate the faculty on good practices
 - d. Use them to evaluate teaching excellence
- 2. Student ratings and feedback
 - a. Student learning environment
 - b. Measures student learning perceptions and satisfaction
 - c. Reports bias and other classroom issues

Additional Categories

- 3. Pedagogy training or innovation
- 4. Reviewing other colleagues
- 5. Inclusive teaching practices
