- 1. CEPP reviewed and approved minutes from December 7.
- 2. Re: FHB syllabus requirement, CC and CAFR will discuss at their meetings and report back. Additional anecdotal feedback:
  - a. General support seemed apparent at C/PD meeting
  - b. Might we work with CLTL for trainings in syllabus best practices?
  - c. Some concern that Thanksgiving remote mandate could be a hardship for NTT faculty who do not have Skidmore issued computers
- 3. Gen Ed Curriculum webpage revamp. Communications and Marketing provided specific questions for CEPP to review concerning the new Gen Ed webpage. CEPP discussed links and/or additional information that could be added into the new Gen Ed Webpage prototype, including number of required credits; links to catalog for descriptions; and accordion menus for each of the Gen Ed area requirements. CEPP also discussed that the historical information would be well-archived on the CEPP website ("Documents and Links"). CEPP reviewed "Quick Links" on current Gen Ed webpage; CEPP suggests removing all "Quick Links" and archive documents (including FAQs) on the CEPP website ("Documents and Links").
  - a. In reviewing the CEPP website, CEPP decided that the CEPP page link to "The Plan for Skidmore" should be removed.
- 4. Next week, Dave DeConno will join the CEPP meeting to discuss how a 5 and 7 year academic calendar planning cycle works. We will also consider the Thanksgiving break remote proposal.
- 5. Thanksgiving Schedule Survey—about 25 departments completed the survey. Data not yet ready to share.
- 6. CEPP discussed ChatGPT and the parameters of academic integrity violations. CEPP will continue to monitor developments.
