## Agenda items:

- 1. CEPP Chair welcomed everyone and the committee approved minutes from 1/27
- 2. Announcements CEPP discussed College initiatives in the context of ongoing disruption from the federal level, and resulting zeitgeist of uncertainty in terms of regulations, accreditation, and funding.
- 3. Kelly Sheppard's updates on the Global Cultural Perspectives assessment tool and writing requirement assessment will be postponed until next meeting.
- 4. CEPP continued to address the process for moving student ratings online, including reaching out broadly for input from key constituencies. CEPP reviewed a draft survey instrument from IR that is aimed at peer institutions, and provided feedback. Trevor Lai and Natalie Koegler shared feedback from students: they would like us to continue to administer evaluations in the classroom, even if an online tool is used. Upper-division students comment that over years they notice when student feedback does not seem to result in changes in courses/instruction. CEPP members noted that our current evaluation tool can be improved some of the data we collect does not help to tell a story, and we are sensitive to the importance of gaining useful results in return for the amount of time and resources that the community commits to evaluation work. In the evaluation space, bias continues to be a concern that flows in both directions, and additional context on the evaluation tools can be provided for example by making available short video introductions. Discussion will continue.
