### 4. Writing Requirement Assessment:

The assessment of the Writing Requirement is delayed to the upcoming academic year so
the English Department has enough personell to conduct a full assessment. This academic
year will be piloting the new rubric and calibrating.

## 5. Summer Online Course Review:

- o Discussed the Skidmore College Summer Online Course Pilot.
- Background: After a pandemic-era experiment with online summer courses, this mode of delivery was paused in summer 2022. The pilot program was intitiated by CEPP in response to a request to the DoF for a resumption of online summer instruction
- o Goal: CEPP to make a recommendation for summer 2026.
- Issues raised:
  - Some faculty oppose online education.
  - Handling departmental curriculum and non-Skidmore faculty teaching summer courses
  - Questions about the Summer Program's goals, delivery mode, revenue, etc.
  - Concerns about screen time for intensive summer courses.
  - Financial implications of students not needing housing for online courses.
