2. Ongoing Business

a. Move to Online Ratings

- Debrief of Friday's COW: The session went well. The committee will meet on 2/10 to continue discussions.
- Staff Forum scheduled for Monday, Feb. 23, 3–4 PM in Emerson.
- CEPP discussion with IR Guests:
 - Online evaluations can include mandatory or optional questions.
 - Student reps shared that mandatory questions are not burdensome.
 - Determination pending on placement of open-ended questions.
 - Discussion on whether pilot should be limited to selected classes or faculty.
 - Idea: pilot a few courses during midterm period.
 - Concern about survey applicability across diverse course types.
 - CEPP members volunteered to assist with aspects of survey design
- Consult with Academic and Student Affairs regarding employment/risk management considerations potentially arising from student responses in existing long forms and potential future.
 - Bias-related concerns are reviewed holistically; evaluations are only one part of evidence.
