1. Minutes get tabled to next week

2. Announcements:

Land Acknowledgment proposed by CIGU, IPPC has already approved, it will come to CEPP.

Trying to align calendar with Indigenous People's Day, CEPP is tabling that until next years.

Adrian: discussion on CIGU about language, striving for balance with acknowledging past and also build up a path forward.

Cory: FEC has approached Dave DeConno, about trying to get one full week of holiday on Thanksgiving, and this will have to come to CEPP as CEPP didn't approve it in the past (on FAQ).

Sense of Faculty supported not holding classes online during Thanksgiving. FEC should had contacted CEPP not Dave DeConno. Amy will reach out to Dave to let him know where we stand.

Natalie will continue to represent SGA and another representative TBD.

3. Ongoing Business:

- a. OCSE/FYE London-FYE Proposal

The proposal has been clarified after consultation with CEPP. We will be not sending the data to faculty, so CEPP will need to make a proposal and be prepared to answer questions regarding the proposal. They will work with CEPP through the process of creating a model for the Global SSP program in its place. We will ask faculty to vote on the Fall (both phasing FYE London and substitute by Global SSP program), so CEPP can work with OCSE on setting the Global SSP program. CEPP chair will make the announcement on the next faculty meeting. A CEPP subcommittee will be set to work with OCSE on setting the Global SSP program.

Corey: We have a time pressure, the phasing out London-FYE and setting Global SSP program needs to be done before the fiscal budget is due.

We propose to introduce the motion in the first meeting in September, introduction of the resolution, on second meeting for voting. Heather suggests that we set up the committee during the transition meeting.

By next week, bring up any questions we have about the Global SSP.

Chair of CEPP should announce that CEPP, OCSE and FYE are in agreement that we don't want to sunset the FYE in London without making sure we set up the Global SSP.

b. FYE Program Review

CEPP agrees with Rachel assessments and suggestions (no caps changes for now, not counting for other all-college requirements, maintaining the ID, make the 4th hour more consistent (which will need to be approved with CEPP)). Working on addressing equity among departments about delivering FYE. Amy suggests change in language to "more transparent" rather than more equitable.

c. Online Evals – Preamble and Best Practices

Heather – email Kerry Nelson for a direction for help, as in the previous form seems to be addressed to faculty.

Javier: some instructions are confusing. Heather: will take a second pass through them to streamline what will be needed for the students vs. faculty. We need to include instructions about when the online ratings will be available for students to complete if they missed them in class.

d. Micro credentialing proposal.

- i. Chair of CEPP – it seems to be the highest trend in Higher Ed.
- ii. Chair thinks we should take it slow. Student Affairs might be in favor of it, but needs more time. Students can get the credentials now from LinkedIn Learning. The CDC is advertising the availability of microcredentially right now. Sunny system has a very clear process about microcredentials. At what point the CDC cross the boundary where CEPP has to step in.
- iii. Adrian: Who should be including in this discussion. It is unclear what the roles of some of the constituents are. Kelly: Ask Matt to bring more streamlined policies and clarity.

CEPP does not endorse the timeline as right now, if there is a proposal it needs to be more streamlined and with more clarity on the policies.
