## Athletic Council Meeting Minutes November 24<sup>th</sup>, 2025

## 9:00-10:00 a.m. Williamson Sports Center Conference Room

Athletic Council Members Present: Daniel Peterson (Chair), Kate Berheide, Megan Buchanan (SWA and AAD), Gail Cummings-Danson (AD and AVPSA), David Cohen (ADOF), Bernardo Ramirez Rios (FAR), Brooke LaValle (SAC Rep), Avery Rogers (SGA Rep), Jamin Totino (OAA), Brenda Pashley-Rabbitt (OAA), and Michael Dunn.

- 1. October meeting minutes approved.
- 2. Continued discussion about student support. Joined by Jamin Totino and Brenda Pashley-Rabbitt.
  - a. Started with a reminder about Athletic survey, SAAC, SGA feedback etc. to increase visibility about what resources are available at Skidmore and Student Academic Services (now Learning Commons)
    - i. Most challenging was time management and balance
  - b. Learning Commons just launched a new website
  - c. Talked about what they currently offer and approach
    - i. They go and meet with teams early in the year
    - ii. Have e-notes, which is a real-time note-taking system for internal use only, so that there is continuity between those who might be communicating or interacting with the systems, including academic alerts.
    - iii. Rachel Roe-Dale, another point of contact for students, especially if they are struggling with their FYE
    - iv. Peer-academic coaching
  - d. They're seeing a need for time management So they started a new program to try and address this. Not athlete-specific, but they would consider a special version of this specifically for athletes
  - e. Shared academic information by team (Fall data only)
  - f. Currently trying to gain more visibility for the Learning Commons
    - i. One tactic is to have teams come to the learning commons when they're doing the beginning of the year orientation – Avery felt that from a student perspective, it might break the stigma or hesitation about using a space like the learning commons to get them more comfortable in the space
  - g. Question, for recruits, is learning commons something that is shown to recruits during the visit? Variable based on the coach, but the admission tour doesn't include the visit

- h. Brooke suggested perhaps include Learning Commons in the Freshman Orientation – Perhaps revive the scavenger hunts for visits to other areas on campus for services, with reminder to put the Annex on it
  - Gail brought up that it probably should look different depending on Fall,
    Winter and Spring, given the timelines
- i. Kate proposed the idea of Athlete-PAC at the sport center and then potentially mandate one visit a week per athlete
- j. Mike proposed the idea of using thespring as a way of utilizing data for accountability etc.
- k. Daniel suggested reaching out to student athletes to test the waters about things like mandated study halls etc.
- I. Avery recommended have somebody from OAA (perhaps Chloe) to come and talk to SAAC
- m. Gail made the point that success is different for each student, so understanding this before addressing the needs is really important
- n. Working on getting students trained on suite of technology that they have access to, to help introduce students to this
- o. Mike suggested perhaps incorporating a study skills and accountability into the Scribner Seminar for peer mentors
- p. PAC students are enrolled into a course in which they can make "modules" for their sessions
- q. David brought up the idea of is there a way if Gail can get all academic alerts for athletes not just failing students. Jamin to follow up with Gail.
- 3. Daniel brought up do we want to meet in December. The answer was yes. Next Meeting 9am, 8<sup>th</sup> of December.
