

The Faculty Advisory Board (FAB) met once in 2018-2019, in response to a request from FEC (Faculty Executive Committee) to create an operating code. With feedback from the FAB, FEC, and VPAA/DOF, the chair in fall (Erica Wojcik) established a FAB operating code : <https://www.skidmore.edu/governance/fab/18-19/OperatingCode-Nov292018.pdf>

Since its establishment in 2015-2016, the FAB also provides faculty to hearings related to student sexual and gender-based misconduct; and, if and when needed, three members to serve on the Administrative Hearing Board (AHB) and one member to serve as Faculty representative in cases of academic integrity violations. Prior to 2015-2016, FEC appointed 6 faculty to the [Integrity Board](#) who could also be impaneled on the AHB; both boards were established by the Dean of Students and VP for Student Affairs. IB and AHB faculty representatives received training in restorative justice and the Skidmore judicial process by Don Hastings (Dean of Student Affairs) and David Karp (Associate Dean of Student Affairs). Current FAB members receive training by Human Resources in matters of discrimination, harassment, and disciplinary proceedings and additional training on sexual and gender-based misconduct by the Dean of Student Affairs Office.

FAB members served on seven student sexual and gender-based misconduct panels in 2018-2019, including one scheduled after the end of the academic year (June 2019).
