FACULTY EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE 2015–16 ANNUAL REPORT

FEC met as a committee 33 times in the 2015–16 academic year. Its main agenda for the year was implementation of the Faculty governance reform that was passed the previous year. To this end, FEC worked on:

- Creating an on-line faculty preference sheet
- Educating faculty on the service cycle
- Conducting on-line elections
- Making appointments from the ad-hoc pool

In order to accomplish this work, FEC worked closely with the IT department and with the VPAA/DOF office. FEC also hosted open for on the implementation of the Faculty governance reform and responded to individual faculty inquiries.
