- I. Meeting commenced at 2:00pm.
- II. February 11th minutes were approved with minimal correction.
- III. Admission working group. Natalie Taylor and Jess Ricker will join the next FEC meeting on 3/4 to discuss plans for nominating faculty members to join a working group.
- IV. Faculty Communication. At the next faculty meeting on 2/27, FEC will announce a faculty-only open forum to discuss the list serv-policy. The forum will take place on Friday 3/27 at 3:30pm in Gannett Hall.
- V. PC Replacement. FEC needs to find a one semester replacement for Fall 2026. The chair of FEC will contact a potential candidate.
- VI. New Governance Cycle. FEC discussed identifying candidates from Cohorts B and C to determine which faculty members stood for election and which ones served. FEC will reach out to Deborah Peterson to confirm the candidates. FEC will also contact IT to update and rearrange the ballot system.
- VII. TT Faculty. FEC addressed the idea in which tenure-faculty might provide input in the upcoming (Spring 27) CBA negotiations and the possibility of creating a task force on tenure.
- VIII. Divisional Representation. FEC considered reviewing the current divisional representation model. FEC will review a proposal and discuss it next week.
