

Summer Housing for May Graduates

A limited number of rooms will be set aside for May graduates engaged in Collaborative Research, a Skidmore sponsored internship (Tang internships for example), or on-campus employment.

- Housing will be limited to the dates of the research, internship, or employment and graduates must leave housing on the specified date.
- May graduates are not eligible for student support services (Counseling for example)
- May graduates will be invoiced upon approval and room and board charges must be paid in full before check in
- May grads will be required to sign a revocable housing agreement
- The revocable housing agreement includes a zero tolerance policy that will require a May grad to leave on-campus housing immediately upon violation of the residential agreement.
- Faculty/supervisors must sign off on the zero tolerance policy so they are aware that regardless of their research, internship, job, the May grad may be asked to leave campus immediately.
- May grads, as well as UG students, will be housed in Jonsson Tower this summer. Apartments will not be available for summer housing. This may be an adjustment for May grads after living in an apartment as a Junior or Senior.
- May graduates' student IDs expire two weeks after graduation. May grads will be required to visit the Card Office after graduation to request and Alumni ID card so they can continue to access their residential space, the dining hall, sport center, etc.
