Forthcoming Change to 2006-2007 *Faculty Handbook*
Faculty Meeting – October 6, 2006

(Part 1, Article IX, Section E, “Procedures for Granting Tenure”):

Old Language (2005-2006):

6. After conducting its deliberations, the CAPT reports its recommendation to the President, the Vice President for Academic Affairs, and the Dean of the Faculty. The President (after consultation with the Vice President for Academic Affairs and with the Dean of the Faculty) and the CAPT report their recommendations to the Board of Trustees. In the rare instance in which the President does not concur with the recommendations of the CAPT, the President will meet with the CAPT before reporting final recommendations to the Board of Trustees to offer detailed and compelling reasons for such disagreement.

New Language (2006-2007):

6. After conducting its deliberations, the CAPT reports its recommendations to the President, the Vice President for Academic Affairs, and the Dean of the Faculty. The Vice President for Academic Affairs then consults with the Dean of the Faculty. In the event of a disagreement between the Vice President for Academic Affairs and the CAPT, the Vice President for Academic Affairs and the Dean of the Faculty meet with the CAPT to discuss the reasons for the disagreement. The Vice President for Academic Affairs then makes a recommendation to the President. In the rare instance in which the President does not concur with the recommendations of the CAPT, the President meets with the CAPT to offer detailed and compelling reasons for such disagreement. Finally, the President and the CAPT report their recommendations to the Board of Trustees.
