MOTION

Motion: That the college's CAFR reduce its faculty membership by one.

Rationale: In response to the faculty's recommendation of a 33% reduction of faculty governance overall, CAFR is confident that it can reduce its size by one faculty member yet remain an effective committee. And, because it is a faculty-only committee, this reduction will not affect a faculty-administrator ratio.

This reduction will also not affect tenured-untenured faculty representation on the committee. CAFR will maintain the requirement that there be at least 1 untenured member at the time of election to the Committee. CAFR recognizes that, at times, the committee may have all tenured members because a member will have gotten tenure while s/he is still on the committee. Although CAFR recognizes this as an ongoing issue, the committee does not believe it can solve the problem and has agreed to let it be.
