Is study abroad in your future? Or where have you studied?

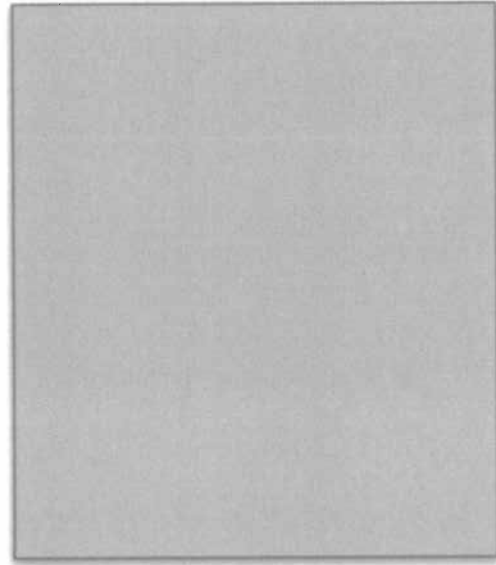
Unfortunately I was unable to study abroad because of my major and my desire to complete a thesis, but I hope to travel and volunteer abroad after graduation!
