



### **David S. Bruce Outstanding Undergraduate Abstract Awards**

The David S. Bruce Outstanding Undergraduate Abstract Awards provide \$100 and a 2-year complimentary membership with The American Physiological Society to undergraduate students who are presenting their research at the Experimental Biology meeting. To be considered for the awards, the candidate must be enrolled as an undergraduate student at the time of the application, be the first author on a submitted abstract for the EB meeting, and be working with an APS member. Selection of awardees is based on the abstract, letter of application, and letter of support from the research host.

### **David S. Bruce Excellence in Undergraduate Research Awards**

The David S. Bruce Excellence in Undergraduate Research Awards provide funds to undergraduate students (\$400) who are presenting their research at the Experimental Biology meeting. To be considered for the awards, the candidate must be enrolled as an undergraduate student at the time of the application; be the first author on a submitted abstract for the EB meeting; be working with an APS member, and have received the Bruce Outstanding Undergraduate Abstract Award. The recipients must attend and present a poster at the meeting. Selection of awardees is based on the quality of the poster and oral presentation of the poster to the David Bruce Award Selection Committee.
