#### CORNELL COOPERATIVE EXTENSION (CCE) WARREN COUNTY

**NEED HELP WITH YOUR TAXES? WE CAN HELP!** - Volunteer Income Tax Assistance Program (VITA) sponsored by Cornell Cooperative Extension of Warren County is offering free income tax assistance to families and individuals whose household income is below \$50,000. Trained community volunteers can help you with special credits, such as Earned Income Tax Credit and Child Tax Credit for which you may qualify. In addition to free tax return preparation assistance, free electronic filing (e-filing) will be offered. Individuals taking advantage of the e-file program will receive their refunds in half the time compared to returns filed on paper – even faster if you have your refund deposited directly into your bank account. 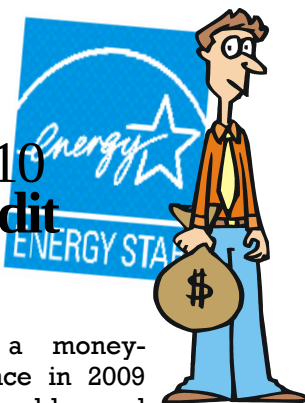

Tax Credit

**D**id you purchase a money-saving appliance in 2009 or 2010? You could spend up to \$5,000 during this two-year period on one or more products for your principal residence that you own and live in, and get 30% or up to \$1,500 (30% of \$5,000 = \$1,500) back as a tax credit. Follow the instructions and deduct it. If you got the entire \$1,500 credit in 2009, then you can't get anything additional in 2010.
