- 7. The parties agree that this is the entire agreement, and no agreement, oral or written, exists outside of this agreement other than the WSPN *Policies and Procedures* document.

RELEASE

The Volunteer releases and discharges the College and its officers, employees, agents and representatives from any responsibility or liability for personal injury, including death, and damage to or loss of property, that Volunteer may incur due to the acts, omissions or negligence of the College, its officers, employees, agents, and representatives while visiting the College or otherwise engaging in activities pursuant to the Agreement.

THIS RELEASE IS ENFORCEABLE TO THE FULLEST EXTENT PERMITTED BY LAW AND INCLUDES A RELEASE FROM LIABILITY FOR ACTS OF NEGLIGENCE BY THE RELEASED PARTIES.
