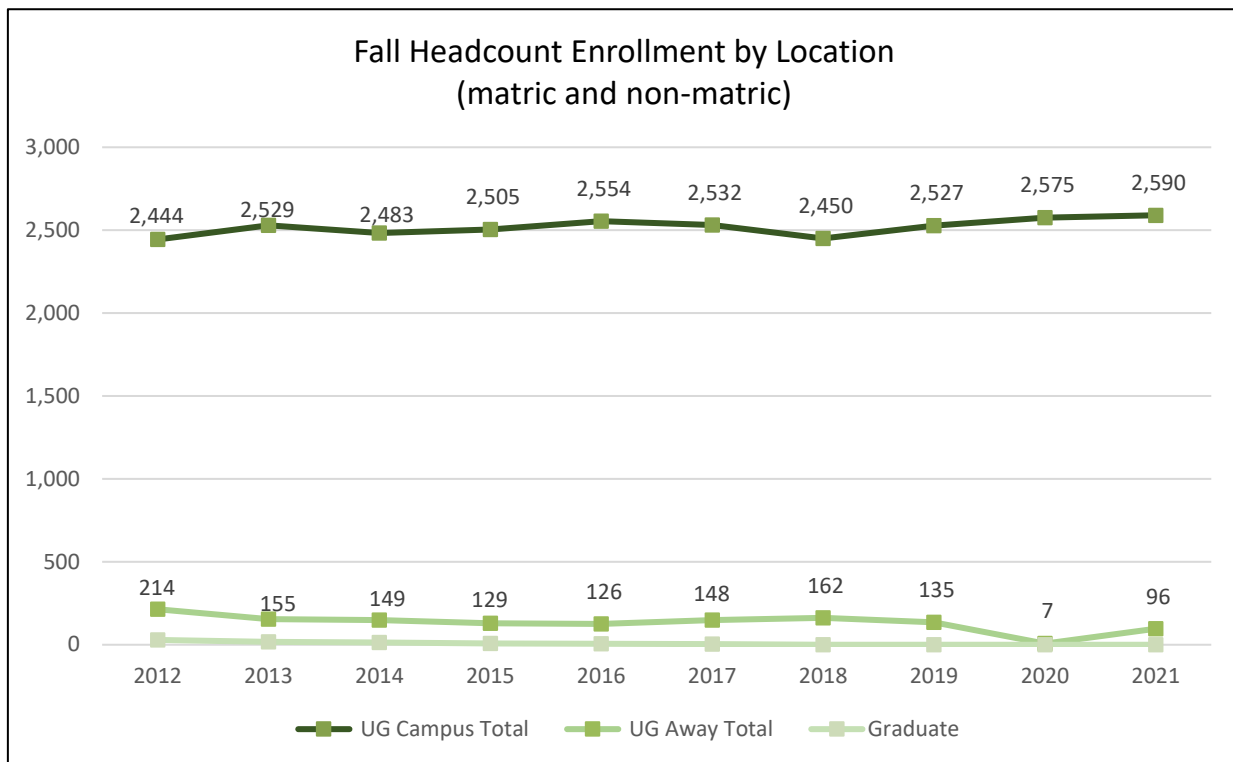

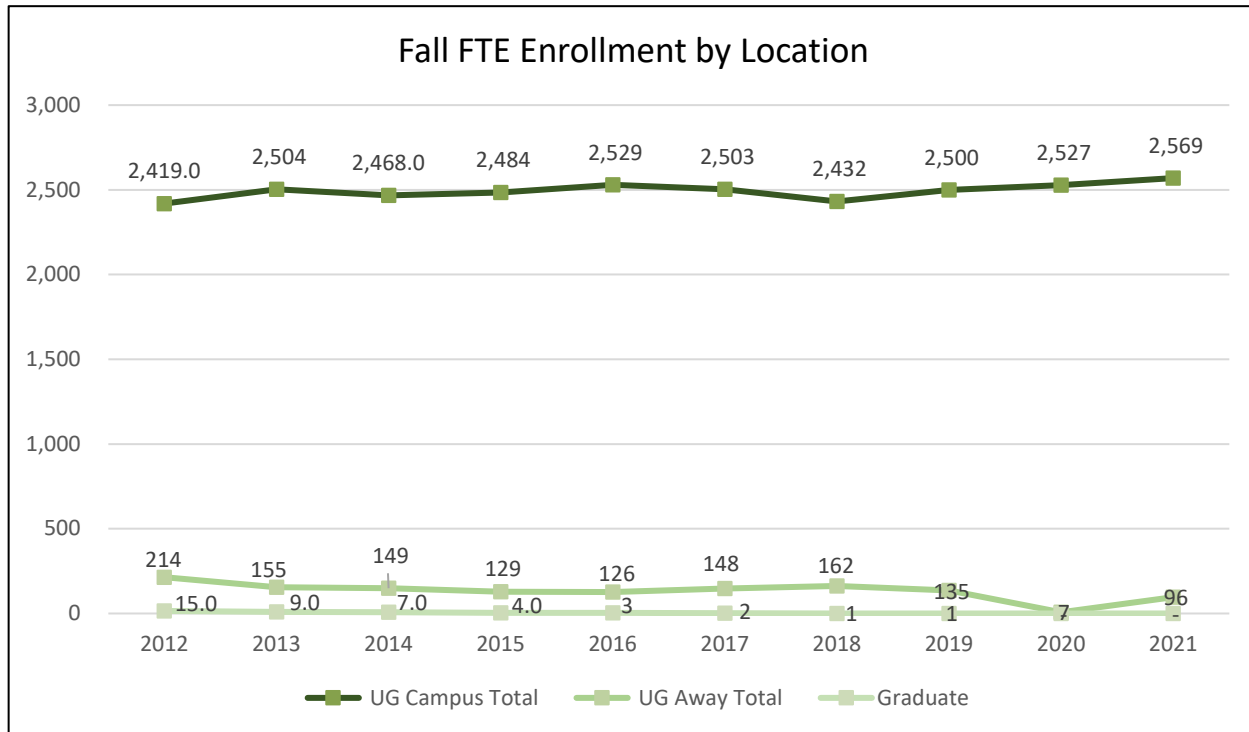

State Distribution of UG, Matriculated On-campus

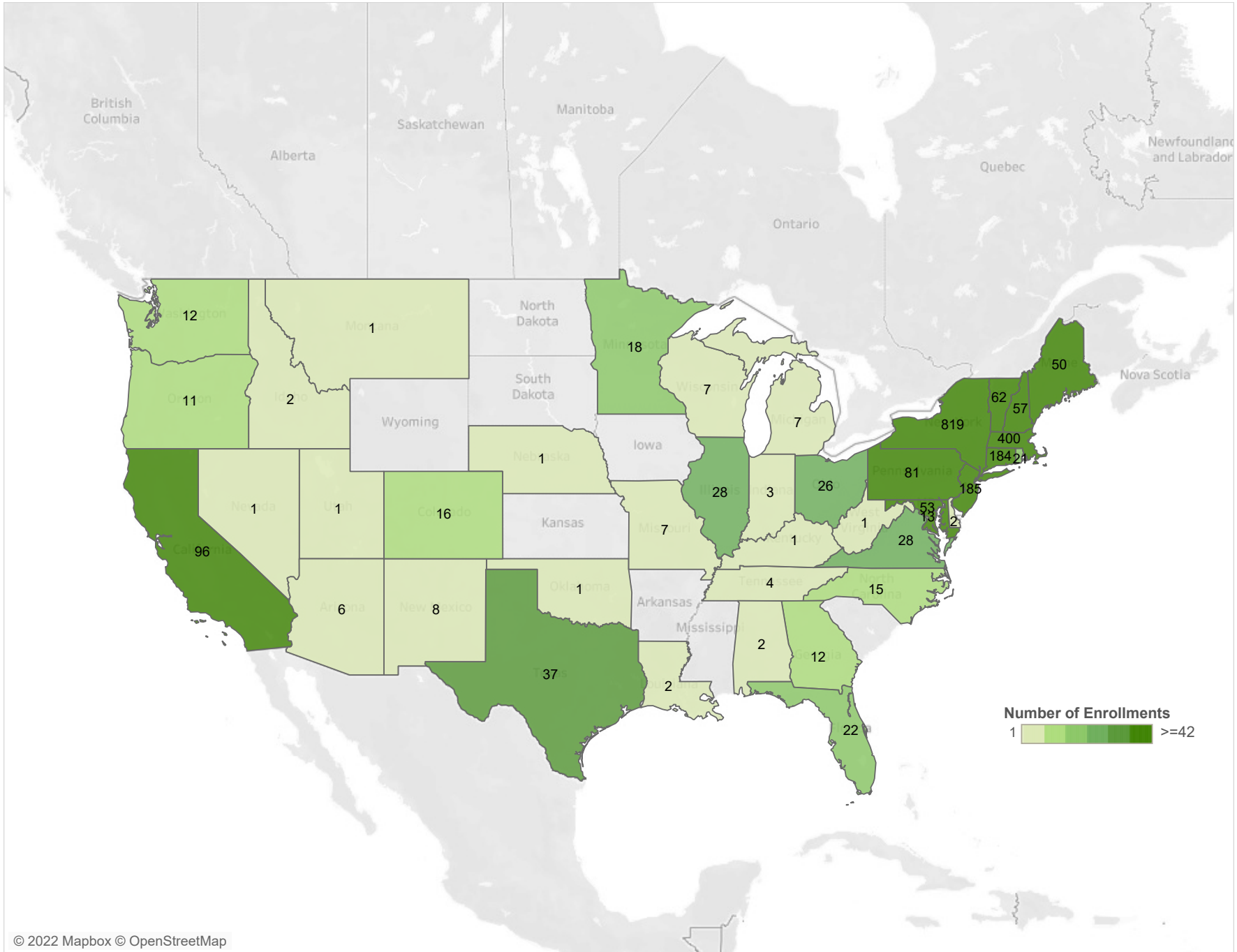

State Distribution of UG, Matriculated On-campus

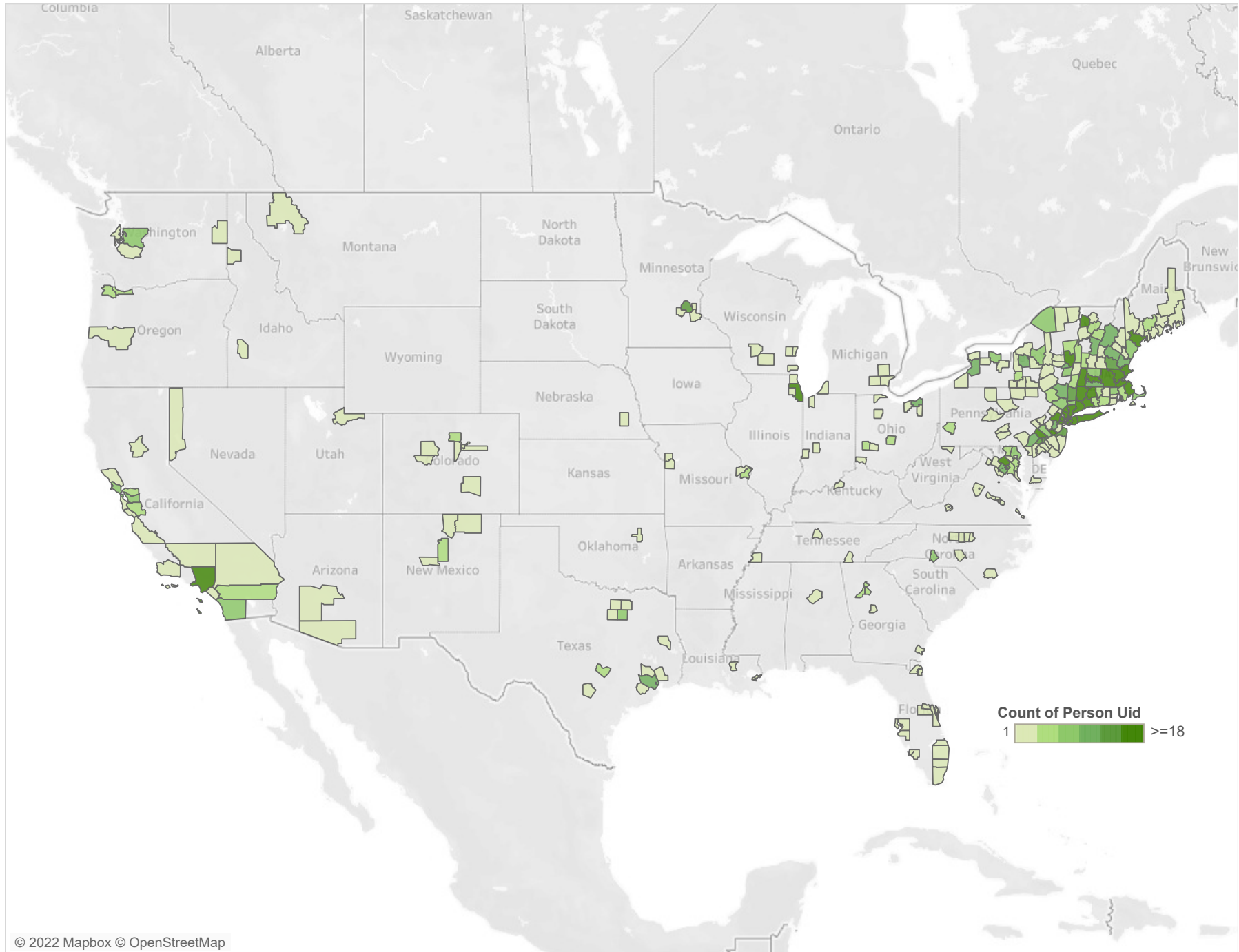

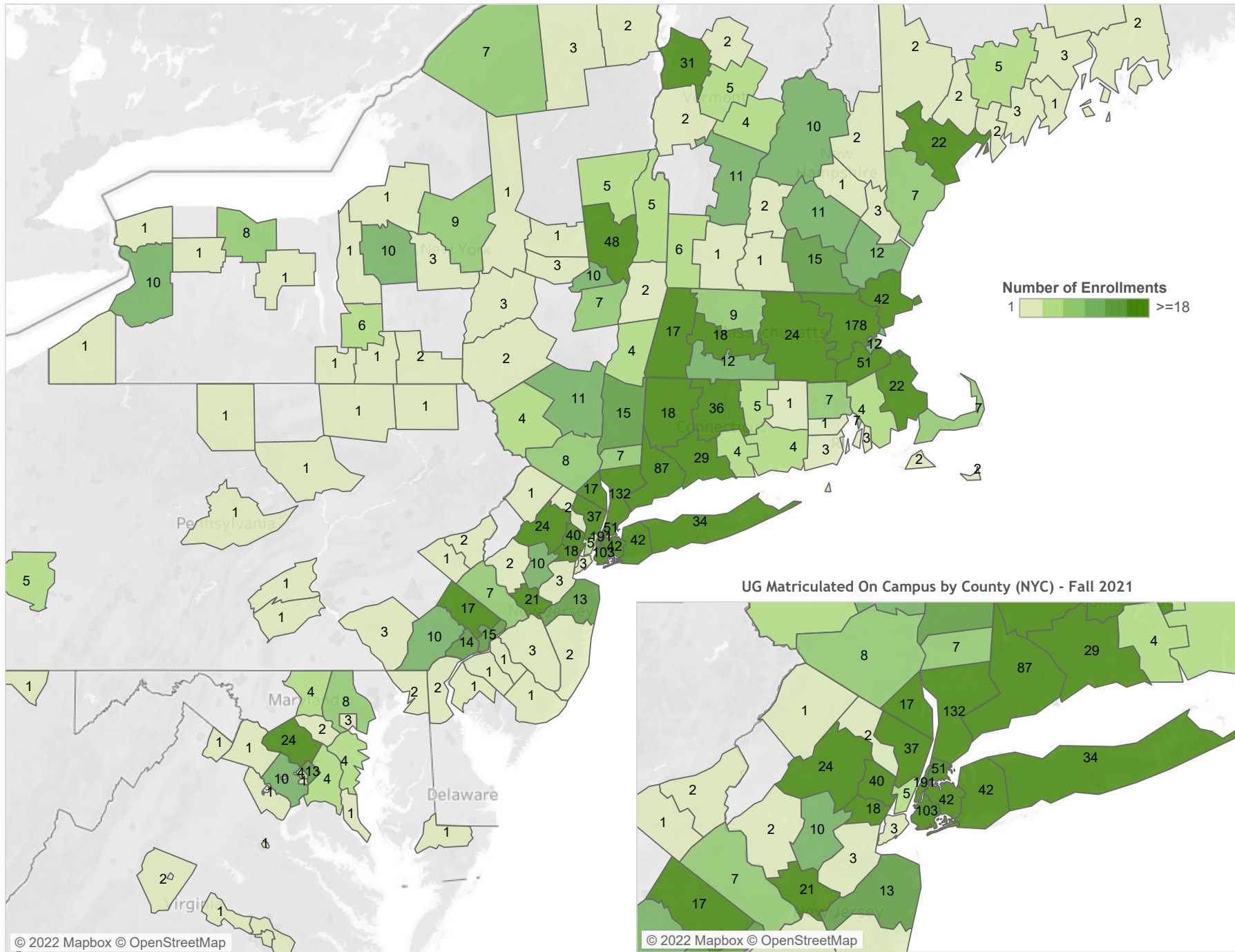
UG Matriculated On Campus by State (US) - Fall 2021

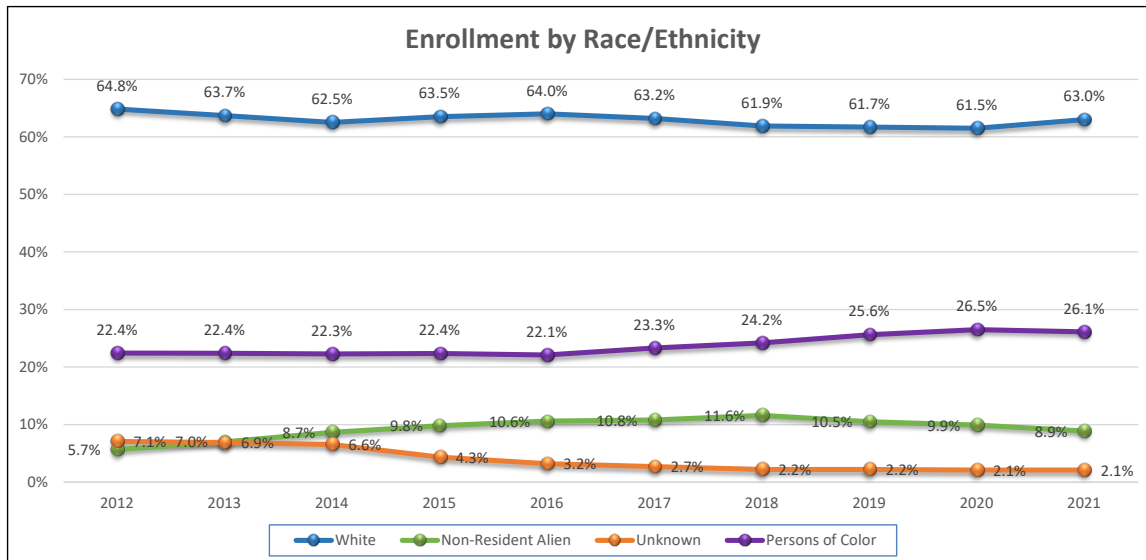
