'Entering class N' and '% returning each fall' are determined on the census date (Oct 5). Classes entering prior to Fall 2001 used a census date of first class day (Sept 5). Differences between rates for those before Fall 2001 and those entering Fall 2001 onward are slight.

All percentages are calculated using the number of students returning/graduating from the entering class cohort. 'Returning' includes only active students enrolled for credits at/through Skidmore College. returning fourth year' excludes students who graduated in 3 years as they are counted under 'graduate in 3 years.'

From 1992 onward, the 12-month reporting period is Sept 1 to Aug 31. You will therefore notice a greater percentage of students graduating in 4 years (below the first solid black line). August graduates (si completing the summer of intended graduation year) are now included in the 4-year column. This change does not affect the overall 6-year graduation rate and is entirely the result of changes in definition federal and state levels.

*Initial cohort size adjusted for allowable IPEDS exclusions: deceased, permanently disabled, armed forces, foreign aid service of the federal government, or official church missions.

2009 cohort adjusted from 664 to 663 due to 1 exclusion starting with '%returning second year'

2015 cohort adjusted from 686 to 684 due to 2 exclusions starting with '%returning second year'

2017 cohort adjusted from 661 to 660 due to 1 exclusion starting with '%3 & 4-year graduation rate'
