Bio

Daniel Huh began his musical journey at the age of six and has since trained under Stella Xu, Phillip Kawin, and Adam Kent. He currently studies with Dr. Kim as a Filene Music Scholar at Skidmore College. An active competitor and collaborator, Daniel is a two-time alternate of the Manhattan School of Music Precollege Concerto Competition and a winner of the Skidmore College Concerto Competition, through which he performed Grieg's Piano Concerto in A Minor with the Skidmore College Orchestra. He has also had the privilege of collaborating with radio host Terrance McKnight and performing Carmina Burana and Bach's Brandenburg Concerto No. 5 with Skidmore Music Ensembles. Recently, he was featured in the Young Musicians Forum recital series at the Schenectady County Public Library and presented a solo recital at Burnt Hills United Methodist Church. Upcoming performances include Gershwin's Rhapsody in Blue for four hands piano with Dr. Kim on April 12 and a collaborative concert with Skidmore dancers later in April.

Outside of music, Daniel is pursuing a double major in Mathematics and Economics at Skidmore College. His thesis examines fairness in judging at the 19th International Chopin Piano Competition in Warsaw, bridging music, economics, and statistics through an analysis of voting systems. He has been working closely with pianist and juror Kevin Kenner and researcher Krzysztof Kontek on unpacking 2025 Chopin Competition data. Beyond academics, Daniel serves as Co-President of the Asian Cultural Association, promoting awareness of Asian cultural events and celebrations on campus. After graduation, he will be relocating to Nashville to begin his professional career.
