Honors requirement in Neuroscience:

To be eligible for honors in Neuroscience, neuroscience majors must meet the GPA requirements set by the College and research requirements set by the program. Specifically, students must have the following:

- 1) Cumulative GPA of 3.500 or higher for work in the major, and a cumulative GPA of 3.000 or higher for all work at Skidmore. The GPA requirement must be met during the spring semester of senior year in order to apply for Honors; and must be maintained at the time of graduation for Honors to be bestowed.
- 2) Successful completion of two semesters worth of 3-credit, 300-level research related to neuroscience (summer research conducted either at Skidmore or at another institution will be considered.)
- 3) Completion and submission of the honors application (more information below) in which the research experiences are described along with their qualification for Honors in Neuroscience.
