JLAH 151 Modern Art in London: From the Sublime to the Ridiculous?	4	Humanistic Inquiry and Practice; fulfills a 100-level elective in the Art History major or minor.
JLAN 251 London Museums: Introduction to British Museology, Society and Culture	4	Humanistic Inquiry and Practice; fulfills a 200-level elective in the Anthropology major or minor.
JLEN 251 Writing the City: London	4	Artistic Inquiry through Practice; fulfills a <i>Forms of Language and Literature</i> for the English major or minor; also fulfills a requirement for the Creative Writing minor.
JLES 100 Global Environmental Change	4	ES 100 Environmental Concerns in Perspective; fulfills ES 100 for Environmental Studies and Sciences majors or minors; fulfills <i>the Physical World</i> foundational requirement in the International Affairs major or minor. Does not fulfill the Scientific Inquiry requirement.
JLMA 111 Calculus I <i>Prerequisite:</i> Must place into an AQR course by either by SAT/ACT score or by taking the QR Placement Diagnostic; students must also take Skidmore's online Calculus placement exam.	4	MA 111 Calculus I; Pre-requisite for <i>MA 113 Calculus II</i> ; Does not fulfill the AQR requirement.
