*You must consult with Skidmore's Institutional Review Board (IRB) or Institutional Animal Care and Use Committee (IACUC), respectively, to determine whether you need to submit an application for review and approval. IRB approval is required if your research 1) involves human subjects (i.e., a living individual about whom an investigator conducting research: obtains information or biospecimens through intervention or interaction with the individual, and uses, studies, or analyzes the information or biospecimens; or obtains, uses, studies, analyzes, or generates identifiable private information or identifiable biospecimens); and 2) meets the federal definition of research (i.e., a systematic investigation designed to develop or contribute to generalizable knowledge). IACUC approval is required if your research involves vertebrate animals, such as mice, rats, fish, reptiles and birds. Wildlife studies involving vertebrate animals also require IACUC approval. All student investigators conducting research involving human subjects or vertebrate animals are expected to conduct their research in an appropriate and ethical manner, and both student investigators and their faculty sponsor must take the appropriate training through CITI Program.
