

All Skidmore College students are required to submit a Personal Evacuation Plan to be used in case of an emergency (such as an extreme weather event) that requires the campus to be vacated. The plan must include the addresses of two different locations within a day's driving distance of Skidmore College, and how you will travel to each destination. The locations could include a home address, if applicable, or that of a friend or family member.

Below you will find a drop down menu listing "Evacuation Location 1" and "Evacuation Location 2." You will need to fill these out with both of your personal evacuation plan locations, one location under each choice on the drop down menu.
