

RETURNING STUDENT HOUSING SELECTION 2026-2027

RESIDENCE HALLS

Application Information

When completing the on-campus housing application, students should indicate if they are interested in living in any Special Interest Housing communities (descriptions are included in the housing application). The Office of Residential Life will review Special Interest Housing Applications and students will be notified if they have been approved to participate in the process.

The housing application will provide students with an opportunity to select potential a roommate for the upcoming year. If you are interested in a single, do not join or create a group.

How does Class Rank and Lottery Number Work?

The student with the higher class year rank and lottery number closest to zero will pick their housing first.

Example

Student A – Class Rank 3.0 - Lottery Number 1250

Student B – Class Rank 2.0 – Lottery Number 2530

Student A picks first because their class rank is better.

If class rank is the same, the student with the lottery number closest to zero picks first.

Example

Student A – Class Rank 2.0 - Lottery Number 2650

Student B – Class Rank 2.0 – Lottery Number 2175

Student B picks first because their lottery number is closer to zero.

What about students selecting double rooms?

When selecting a double, two students must each list one another as their preferred roommate. The student with the best class rank and lottery number (closest to zero) will get the earliest time slot, however either student may secure the space during their respective time slot.
