9. Old Business
 - a. **Resolution 36-03: SGA Mentoring Program Creation Act (10 minutes)**
Sponsors: S. Lobron, S. Kostbar, S. Glanville
 - i. Introduction by S. Lobron
 1. S. Lobron introduced the act. The requirements for which senators can become senators upon request have been changed and are still at the discretion of the SGA President and the Director of the Office of Leadership Activities.
 - ii. Q&A Period

1. S. Ziek wondered what other ideas were potentially shot down. S. Lobron stated that discussions about seniority occurred. S. Shoemaker asked if the program was intended for all new Senators or just first-years. It will be for all new Senators. S. Lipman asked what skills will be valued. S. Lobron stated that mentors will offer guidance on relevant skills such as public speaking, conflict resolution, how to craft legislation etc. S. Khan asked what will be judged when assigning mentees. S. Kostbar replied that it will be a very holistic process. S. Lobron added that Senators can speak to the SGA President or Director of Leadership Activities if they are wondering why they were not chosen. S. Nwosu asked if there is a specific number of mentors needed. S. Lobron stated that it will depend on how many new Senators are elected.

e. Information Session on the CIA Working Group (25-30 minutes)

- i. Introduction and Presentation by SGA President Majiedt, S. Kostbar and S. Shoemaker
 1. C. Majiedt introduced the CIA working group and noted that the 23-24 academic year included a major restructuring for the SGA structure. S. Kostbar stated that the project began in April 2025 and the group met biweekly. The group's plan is to start a new committee called the Committee on Institutional Accessibility and introduce a new ExComm role: the Vice President for Institutional Accessibility. The group studied the New York 6 schools. Two resolutions have been written.
- ii. Q/A Period
 1. S. Koegler asked how the group plans to fill the committee with Senators. S. Kostbar noted that typically seats are filled by Senators sitting on IPPC and other committees, but there are currently Senators that need seats on committees. S. Khan how the VPIA would be elected. It would follow the standard election process of all VPs. S. Ziek asked how disability representation would be handled. S. Kostbar stated that matters of access affect anyone and representation is important. S. Kostbar stated that they have spoken to professors but don't have any specific faculty partners. S. Lipman asked if the committee will be open or closed. S. Kostbar stated that it would be up to the VPIA. S. Koegler asked if the 38 committee seats include those who sit on all college committees. C. Majiedt noted it included SGA committees.
