Your Instrument (except piano and vibes). Drummers: please bring your drums and any Latin percussion instruments you may own (see the Program Information sheet if you would like to ship them in advance). Bass players are expected to bring their acoustic bass, bow, pick and amp (including cords and extension cords). Guitar players should bring their guitar amp, cords and extension cords.
