2. I KNOWINGLY AND FREELY ASSUME ALL SUCH RISKS, both known and unknown, and assume full responsibility for my participation; and,
3. I, for myself and on behalf of my heirs, assigns, personal representative and next of kin, HEREBY RELEASE, INDEMNIFY, AND HOLD HARMLESS **SKIDMORE COLLEGE**, its officers, officials, agents and/or employees, other participants, sponsoring agencies, sponsors, advertisers, and if applicable, owners and lessor of the premises used to conduct the event ("Release"), WITH RESPECT TO AND ALL INJURY, DISABILITY, DEATH, or loss or damage to person or property, WHETHER ARISING FROM THE NEGLIGENCE OF THE RELEASEES OR OTHERWISE, to the fullest extent permitted by the law.

Please read carefully before initialing and signing!!!

- ☐ A valid Skidmore College photo ID card must be presented for approval to check out a bicycle.
 - ☐ All equipment is to be returned by the time the library closes the same day that it is checked out. Fill out a Bike Damage Report if there are any problems with the bicycle.
 - ☐ A fine of \$5.00 per day will be assessed on keys returned late. A \$15 replacement fee will be charged for lost keys. No bikes may be borrowed if a student has outstanding fines. Do not leave keys in the book return; hand them directly to a staff person at the Circulation Desk.
 - ☐ Bicycles are to be returned to the exact spot on the bike rack from which it was taken. The racks will be inspected daily, and failure to return the bike to its designated location upon returning the key will result in a \$100 fine (the cost of a new bike).
 - ☐ Bicycle Program privileges may be revoked for unsafe or rude conduct or failure to obey instructions.
 - ☐ Bicycle equipment is intended for riding on paved roadways only.
 - ☐ Full responsibility is assumed if the bicycle or other equipment is damaged or stolen while in my possession. I will be held accountable for the replacement/repair cost of:
\$100.00 - Bicycle \$ 50.00 - Bicycle Helmet (if provided with bike)
\$ 10.00 - Bicycle Lock
 - ☐ Bicycle helmets are not required by law, but are highly recommended, and students should understand that they assume any additional risks by not wearing one.
 - ☐ Students are expected to understand hazards posed by other bicycles, traffic or road conditions and observe all traffic laws, follow safe procedures and to avoid unnecessary, hazardous situations.
 - ☐ Students should understand that there are risks involved in cycling and that serious injuries are a possible occurrence.
 - ☐ Students are responsible for any damage(s) to pedestrians, property or automobiles caused while operating bicycles.
 - ☐ Students must be in proper physical condition to cycle and agree that Skidmore College has no obligation to provide a physical examination to evidence their fitness.
