EcoMore Team members are not expected to be well-versed in campus sustainability or climate solutions, and the meetings through the semester will include training. A strong EcoMore candidate will enthusiastically support hands-on sustainability work on campus and be excited to engage with peers at events. We seek a team of diverse interests, academic majors, and identities.

Responsibilities

- Attend, participate, and contribute in bi-monthly team meetings
- Staff educational events, such as food waste buffets in the Dining Hall, waste audits sorting materials from landfill bins, tabling, running the office smoothie bike, etc.
- Support Zero-Waste Events by patrolling waste stations and talking to event attendees
- Work 3 Compost Work Parties and 2 Garden Work Parties each semester with guidance from student program managers

Requirements

- Commitment to making the team and programming a welcome and safe space for all identities, races, gender identities, abilities, and religious-affiliations
- Can-do attitude to support Zero Waste Events and audits
- Clear weekly communication with supervisor
- Availability on Friday's 3-5pm for Compost Work Parties and/or Sundays 3-5pm for Garden Work Parties
